About the speakers



Sir Nicholas Forwood was made Queen's Counsel in 1987 and was appointed to the CJEU (Court of Justice of the European Union) as a judge of the then Court of First Instance of the EC in December 1999. At White & Case, Sir Nicholas focusses on providing high-level advice in the field of EU law, particularly competition.



Professor Henkel is a professor of technology and innovation management with the TUM School of Management (Technical University Munich). His research focuses on technology acquisitions, digitalization, open and user innovation and patent management.



Professor Chrocziel is a professor at the University of Erlangen-Nurnberg, Bavaria, where he teaches IP and competition law. He was admitted to the German Bar in 1983 and to the New York courts and the US Court of Appeals for the Federal Circuit, as well as the US Court of International Trade. He is a partner with the law firm Badehle Pagenberg.



Professor Donle is honorary professor at a university in Berlin where he gives lectures on IP law. He was involved in legislative procedures of the Bundestag as an expert and prepared comments on legislative procedures of the Bundestag for associations and public-law corporations. He is a partner with the law firm Preu Bohlig.



Mr Klaus Haft is a trial lawyer in the field of intellectual property with a particular emphasis on patent litigation. He is Past President of the European Patent Lawyers Association (EPLAW) and member of the advisory board and Past-Secretary of the Licensing Executives Society (LES) Germany. He is a partner with the law firm Hoyng Rokh Monegier.



Dr Vittorio Cerulli Irelli is a litigator with 10 years courtroom experience, Vittorio has successfully represented many multinational companies before the Italian and European Union courts and agencies in a broad range of high-profile cases with an international dimension.
